The kindergarten classes baked adorable baby Moshe cookies. The two- and three-year-old classes colored, painted and glued baby Moshe projects to bring home.

Our preschoolers are proud of their Jewish names! Morah Evida's Pre-Nursery children designed beautiful name necklaces and name plaques when they learned that the Yidden in Mitzrayim did not change their Jewish names.

Learning the bracha of Mezonos was fun and delicious! Sprinkle cookies, chocolate chip cookies, Riced Krispies treats and Smores were on the snack menu this week. The children loved making brachos loud and clear so everyone can answer "amein." Morah Esther's class are "as a cute as a cookie" as it says on their Mezonos magnets.

The 3K classes began a new exploration, "Investigating." They began by investigating snow.
